RETURN

CAST: YESHUA, JOHN, ANGEL 1,2,3,4, FOUR LIVING CREATURES, ELDER 1,2,3 KING OF THE EARTH 1, 2, NON-SPEAKING: SLAIN LAMB, ANTI-CHRIST (BEAST), FALSE PROPHET

(SHOW JOHN WRITING A LETTER- YOU HEAR HIS VOICE AS THE NARRATOR- PRE-RECORDED)

The revelation of Yeshua the Messiah, which God gave Him to show to His servants the things that must soon take place. He made it known by sending His angel to His servant John, who testified to the word of God and to the testimony of Yeshua the Messiah—to everything he saw. How fortunate is the one who reads the words of this prophecy, and those who hear and keep what has been written in it—for the time is near.

John, To Messiah's seven communities in Asia: Grace to you and shalom from Him who is and who was and who is to come, as well as from the seven spirits who are before His throne, and from Messiah Yeshua, the faithful witness, the firstborn of the dead, and the ruler of the kings of the earth. To Him who loves us and has freed us from our sins by His blood and made us a kingdom, kohanim to His God and Father—to Him be glory and power forever! Amen! Look, He is coming with the clouds, and every eye shall see Him, even those who pierced Him. And all the tribes of the earth shall mourn because of Him. Yes, amen!

YESHUA- I am the Alpha and the Omega,

says Adonai Elohim,

YESHUA- Who is and who was and who is to come, the Almighty!

I, John, your brother and fellow partaker with you in the tribulation and kingdom and patient endurance that are in Yeshua, was on the island called Patmos because of the word of God and the testimony of Yeshua. I was in the Ruach on the Day of the Lord, and I heard behind me a loud voice like that of a trumpet, saying,

<u>YESHUA</u>- Write what you see in a scroll, and send it to Messiah's seven communities—to Ephesus and to Smyrna and to Pergamum and to Thyatira and to Sardis and to Philadelphia and to Laodicea."

Then I turned to see the voice that was speaking to me. And when I turned, I saw seven golden menorot. In the midst of the menorot, I saw One like a Son of Man, clothed in a robe down to His feet, with a golden belt wrapped around His chest. His head and His hair were white like wool, white like snow, and His eyes like a flame of fire. His feet were like polished bronze refined in a furnace, and His voice was like the roar of rushing waters. In His right hand He held seven stars, and out of His mouth came forth a sharp, two-edged sword. His face was like the sun shining at full strength. When I saw Him, I fell at His feet like a dead man. But He placed His right hand on me, saying,

YESHUA- Do not be afraid! I am the First and the Last, and the One who lives. I was dead, but look—I am alive forever and ever! Moreover, I hold the keys of death and Sheol. Therefore write down what you have seen, what is, and what will happen after these things. As for the mystery of the seven stars that you saw in My right hand, and the seven golden menorot—the seven stars are the angels of Messiah's seven communities, and the seven menorahs are the seven communities."

And I saw in the right hand of the One seated upon the throne a scroll, written on both the front and the back, sealed with seven seals. I also saw a mighty angel proclaiming with a loud voice,

ANGEL 1- Who is worthy to open the scroll and to break its seals? No one in heaven or on the earth or under the earth was able to open the scroll or to look into it.

I began to weep loudly because no one was found worthy to open the scroll or to look into it. Then one of the elders tells me,

<u>ELDER 1-</u> Stop weeping! Behold, the Lion of the tribe of Judah, the Root of David, has triumphed—He is worthy to open the scroll and its seven seals."

And in the midst of the throne and the four living creatures, and in the midst of the elders, I saw a Lamb standing, as having been slain—having seven horns and seven eyes, which are the seven spirits of God sent out into all the earth. He came and took the scroll from the right hand of the One seated on the throne. When He had taken the scroll, the four living creatures and the twenty-four elders fell down before the Lamb, each holding a harp and golden bowls full of incense—which are the prayers of the kedoshim.

And they are singing a new song, saying,

ELDER 1,2,3- You are worthy to take the scroll and to open its seals. For You were slain, and by Your blood You redeemed for God those from every tribe and tongue and people and nation. You have made them for our God a kingdom and kohanim, and they shall reign upon the earth.

Then I looked, and I heard the voice of many angels around the throne and the living creatures and the elders—their number was myriads of myriads and thousands of thousands. They were chanting with a loud voice,

ANGELS 1,2,3,4, LIVING CREATURES 1,2,3,4, ELDERS 1,2,3- Worthy is the Lamb who was slain, to receive power and riches and wisdom and might and honor and glory and blessing!

And I heard every creature in heaven and on the earth and under the earth and on the sea and everything in them, responding,

ANGELS 1,2,3,4, LIVING CREATURES 1,2,3,4, ELDERS 1,2,3- To the One seated on the throne and to the Lamb be blessing and honor and glory and power forever and ever!

And the four living creatures kept saying,

FOUR LIVING CREATURES- Amen!

And the elders fell down and worshiped. Then I saw when the Lamb opened one of the seven seals, and I heard one of the four living creatures say with a voice like thunder,

LIVING CREATURE 1- Come!

I looked, and behold, there was a white horse. The one riding on it had a bow, and a crown was given to him. He went out as a conqueror so he might conquer. When the Lamb opened the second seal, I heard the second living creature saying,

LIVING CREATURE 2- Come!

Then another horse came out, fiery red. The one riding on it was permitted to take peace from the earth, so that people would slaughter one another. He was given a great sword. When the Lamb opened the third seal, I heard the third living creature saying,

LIVING CREATURE 3- Come!

And behold, I saw a black horse. The one riding on it held a balance scale in his hand. Then I heard something like a voice in the midst of the four living creatures saying,

LIVING CREATURE 4- A quart of wheat for a denarius, and three quarts of barley for a denarius—but do no harm to the oil and wine!"

When the Lamb opened the fourth seal, I heard the fourth living creature saying,

LIVING CREATURE 4- Come!

Behold, I saw a horse, pale greenish gray. The name of the one riding on it was Death, and Sheol was following with him. Authority was given to them over a fourth of the earth, to kill by sword and by famine and by plague and by the wild beasts of the earth. When the Lamb opened the fifth seal, I saw under the altar the souls of those slaughtered for the sake of the word of God and for the witness they had. And they cried out with a loud voice, saying,

<u>SOULS-</u> O Sovereign Master, holy and true, how long before You judge those who dwell on the earth and avenge our blood?

Then a white robe was given to each of them, and they were told to

ANGEL 1- rest a little while longer, until the number of their fellow servants was complete—their brothers and sisters who were to be killed as they had been.

I saw when the Lamb opened the sixth seal, and there was a great earthquake. The sun became as black as sackcloth made of goat's hair, and the full moon became like blood. The stars of heaven fell to the earth like a fig tree drops unripe figs when shaken by a great wind. The heaven ripped apart like a scroll being rolled up, and every mountain and island was moved from their places. Then the kings of the earth and the great men and the military commanders and the rich and the mighty and everyone—slave and free—hid themselves in the caves and among the rocks of the mountains. And they tell the mountains and the rocks,

KINGS ON THE EARTH- Fall on us, and hide us from the face of the One seated on the throne and from the wrath of the Lamb. For the great day of their wrath has come, and who is able to stand?"

After this, I saw four angels standing at the four corners of the earth, holding back the four winds of the earth so that no wind would blow on the earth or on the sea or against any tree. Then I saw another angel coming up from the east, having the seal of the living God. He cried out with a loud voice to the four angels who were permitted to harm the earth and the sea, saying,

ANGEL 5- Do no harm to the earth or the sea or the trees, until we have put a seal on the foreheads of the servants of our God.

Now I heard the number of those marked with the seal:

ANGEL 5- 144,000 from every tribe of Bnei-Yisrael—12,000 from the tribe of Judah; 12,000 from the tribe of Reuben; 12,000 from the tribe of Gad; 12,000 from the tribe of Asher; 12,000 from the tribe of Naphtali; 12,000 from the tribe of Manasseh; 12,000 from the tribe of Simeon; 12,000 from the tribe of Levi; 12,000 from the tribe of Issachar; 12,000 from the tribe of Zebulun; 12,000 from the tribe of Joseph; 12,000 from the tribe of Benjamin.

After these things I looked, and behold, a vast multitude that no one could count—from every nation and all tribes and peoples and tongues—was standing before the throne and before the Lamb. They were clothed in white robes, with palm branches in their hands and crying out with a loud voice, saying,

VAST PEOPLE'S- Salvation belongs to our God, who sits on the throne, and to the Lamb!

And all the angels were standing around the throne, along with the elders and the four living creatures; and they fell on their faces before the throne and worshiped God, saying,

ANGELS, ELDERS, FOUR LIVING CREATURES - Amen, blessing and glory and wisdom and thanksgiving and honor and power and might belong to our God forever and ever. Amen!

Then one of the elders answered, saying to me,

ELDER- Who are these dressed in white robes, and where have they come from?

I said to him, "Sir, you know." Then he said to me,

<u>ELDER-</u> These are the ones coming out of the great tribulation. They have washed their robes and made them white in the blood of the Lamb. For this reason, they are before the throne of God, and they serve Him day and night in His Temple. The One seated on the throne will shelter them. They shall never again go hungry, nor thirst anymore; the sun shall not beat down on them, nor any scorching heat. For the Lamb in the midst of the throne shall shepherd them and guide them to springs of living water, and God shall wipe away every tear from their eyes.

After these things, I heard something like the loud voice of a great multitude in heaven, shouting:

ALL IN HEAVEN- "Halleluyah! Salvation and glory and power belong to our God.

For His judgments are true and just. For He has judged the great prostitute who corrupted the earth with her whoring, and has avenged the blood of His servants caused by her hand."

And a second time they shouted,

ALL IN HEAVEN- Halleluyah! The smoke from her goes up forever and ever!

Then the twenty-four elders and the four living creatures fell down and worshiped God who is seated on the throne, saying,

ELDERS, FOUR LIVING CREATURES- Amen! Halleluyah!"

Then a voice came from the throne, saying:

ANGEL 2- Praise our God, all you His servants and all who fear Him, both the small and the great!

Then I heard something like the voice of a great multitude—like the roar of rushing waters or like the rumbling of powerful thunder—saying,

ANGELS, ELDERS, FOUR LIVING CREATURES & SAINTS & ANGEL 2- Halleluyah! For Adonai Elohei-Tzva'ot reigns! Let us rejoice and be glad and give the glory to Him! For the wedding of the Lamb has come, and His bride has made herself ready, She was given fine linen to wear, bright and clean! For the fine linen is the righteous deeds of the kedoshim.- DJ

Then the angel tells me,

ANGEL1- Write: How fortunate are those who have been invited to the wedding banquet of the Lamb!

He also tells me,

ANGEL1- These are the true words of God.

Then I fell down at his feet and worshiped him. But he said to me,

<u>ANGEL1-</u> See that you do not do that—for I am only a fellow servant with you and your brothers and sisters who hold to the testimony of Yeshua. Worship God! For the testimony of Yeshua is the Spirit of Prophecy."

Then I saw heaven opened, and behold, a white horse! The One riding on it is called Faithful and True, and He judges and makes war in righteousness. His eyes are like a flame of fire, and many royal crowns are on His head. He has a name written that no one knows except Himself. He is clothed in a robe dipped in blood, and the name by which He is called is

ANGEL1- the Word of God.

And the armies of heaven, clothed in fine linen, white and clean, were following Him on white horses. From His mouth comes a sharp sword—so that with it He may strike down the nations—and He shall rule them with an iron rod, and He treads the winepress of the furious wrath of Elohei-Tzva'ot. On His robe and on His thigh He has a name written,

ANGEL1- King of kings, and Lord of lords.

Then I saw a single angel standing in the sun, and with a loud voice he cried out to all the birds flying high in the sky, (on the earth)

<u>ANGEL 2-</u> Come, gather for the great banquet of God— to eat the flesh of kings and the flesh of generals and the flesh of mighty men, the flesh of horses and those riding on them, the flesh of all men, both free and slave, both small and great!

Also I saw the beast and the kings of the earth and their armies gathered together to make war against the One who sat on the horse and against His army. Then the beast was captured, and along with him the false prophet who had performed the signs before him by which he deceived those who had received the mark of the beast, as well as those who had worshiped his image. These two were thrown alive into the lake of fire burning with brimstone. The rest were killed with the sword coming out of the mouth of the One riding on the horse. And all the birds gorged themselves with their flesh. Then I saw an angel coming down from heaven, holding in his hand the key to the abyss and a great chain. He seized the dragon—the ancient serpent, who is the devil and satan—and bound him for a thousand years. He also threw him into the abyss and locked and sealed it over him, so that he would not deceive the nations any longer, until the thousand years were completed. After these things, he must be released for a short while. Then I saw thrones, and people sat upon them—those to whom authority to judge was given. And I saw the souls of those who had been beheaded because of their testimony for Yeshua and because of the word of God. They had not worshiped the beast or his image, nor had they received his mark on their forehead or on their hand. And they came to life and reigned with the Messiah for a thousand years. The rest of the dead did not come to life until the thousand years were completed. This is the first resurrection.

<u>ANGEL1-</u> How fortunate and holy is the one who has a share in the first resurrection! Over such the second death has no authority, but they shall be kohanim of God and the Messiah, and they shall reign with Him for a thousand years.

When the thousand years has ended, satan shall be released from his prison, and he shall come out to deceive the nations at the four corners of the earth, Gog and Magog, to gather them for the battle. Their number is like the sand of the sea. And they came up on the broad plain of the earth and surrounded the camp of the kedoshim and the beloved city—but fire fell from heaven and consumed them. And the devil who deceived them was thrown into the lake of fire and brimstone, where the beast and the false prophet are too, and they shall be tortured day and night forever and ever. Then I saw a great white throne, and the One seated on it. The earth and heaven fled from His presence, but no place was found for them. And I saw the dead—the great and the small—standing before the throne. The books were opened, and another book was opened—the Book of Life. And the dead were judged according to what was written in the books, according to their deeds. The sea gave up the dead that were in it, and death and Sheol gave up the dead in them. Then they were each judged, each one of them, according to their deeds. Then death and Sheol were thrown into the lake of fire. This is the second death—the lake of fire. And if anyone was not found written in the Book of Life, he was thrown into the lake of fire. Then I saw a new heaven and a new earth; for the first heaven and the first earth had passed away, and the sea was no more. I also saw the holy city—the New Jerusalem—coming down out of heaven from God, prepared as a bride adorned for her husband. I also heard a loud voice from the throne, saying,

ANGEL 2- Behold, the dwelling of God is among men, and He shall tabernacle among them. They shall be His people, and God Himself shall be among them and be their God. He shall wipe away every tear from their eyes, and death shall be no more. Nor shall there be mourning or crying or pain any longer, for the former things have passed away.

And the One seated upon the throne said,

YESHUA- Behold, I am making all things new!

Then He said.

YESHUA- Write, for these words are trustworthy and true.

Then He said to me.

YESHUA- It is done! I am the Alpha and the Omega, the Beginning and the End. To the thirsty I will freely give from the spring of the water of life. The one who overcomes shall inherit these things, and I will be his God and he shall be My son. But for the cowardly and faithless and detestable and murderers and sexually immoral and sorcerers and idolaters and all liars—their lot is in the lake that burns with fire and brimstone, which is the second death.

Then came one of the seven angels holding the seven bowls full of the seven final plagues, and he spoke with me, saying,

ANGEL 3- Come, I will show you the bride, the wife of the Lamb.

Then he carried me away in the Ruach to a great and high mountain, and he showed me the holy city, Jerusalem, coming down out of heaven from God, having the glory of God—her radiance like a most precious stone, like a jasper, sparkling like crystal. She had a great, high wall, with twelve gates, and above the gates twelve angels. On the gates were inscribed the names of the twelve tribes of Bnei-Yisrael— three gates on the east, three gates on the north, three gates on the south, and three gates on the west. And the wall of the city had twelve foundations, and on them the twelve names of the twelve emissaries of the Lamb. The angel speaking with me had a gold measuring rod to measure the city and its gates and walls. The city is laid out as a square—its length the same as its width. He measured the city with the rod—

ANGEL 1- 12,000 stadia. Its length and width and height are equal.

He also measured its wall—

ANGEL 1- 144 cubits by human measurement, which is also an angel's measurement.

The material of the city's wall was jasper, while the city was pure gold, clear as glass. The fou ndations of the city wall were decorated with every kind of precious stone—the first foundation was jasper;

ANGEL 1- the second, sapphire; the third, chalcedony; the fourth, emerald; the fifth, sardonyx; the sixth, carnelian; the seventh, yellow topaz; the eighth; beryl; the ninth, topaz; the tenth, chrysoprase; the eleventh, jacinth; the twelfth, amethyst.

And the twelve gates were twelve pearls—each of the gates was from a single pearl. And the street of the city was pure gold, transparent as glass. I saw no temple in her, for its Temple is Adonai Elohei-Tzva'ot and the Lamb. And the city has no need for the sun or the moon to shine on it, for the glory of God lights it up, and its lamp is the Lamb.

ANGEL 1- The nations shall walk by its light, and the kings of the earth bring their glory into it. Its gates shall never be shut by day, for there shall be no night there! And they shall bring into it the glory and honor of the nations. And nothing unholy shall ever enter it, nor anyone doing what is detestable or false, but only those written in the Book of Life.

Then the angel showed me a river of the water of life—bright as crystal, flowing from the throne of God and of the Lamb, down the middle of the city's street. On either side of the river was a tree of life, bearing twelve kinds of fruit, yielding its fruit each month; and the leaves of the tree were for the healing of the nations.

ANGEL 1- No longer will there be any curse. The throne of God and of the Lamb shall be in the city, and His servants shall serve Him. They shall see His face, and His name shall be on their foreheads. Night shall be

no more, and people will have no need for lamplight or sunlight—for Adonai Elohim will shine on them. And they shall reign forever and ever!

He said to me,

ANGEL 1- These words are trustworthy and true! Adonai, the God of the spirits of the prophets, has sent His angel to show His servants what must happen soon.

YESHUA- Behold, I am coming soon! How fortunate is the one who keeps the words of the prophecy of this book.

I, John, am the one hearing and seeing these things. And when I heard and saw them, I fell down to worship at the feet of the angel showing me these things. But He tells me,

ANGEL 1- See that you do not do that! I am a fellow servant with you and your brothers the prophets and those keeping the words of this book. Worship God!

Then he tells me,

ANGEL 1- Do not seal up the words of the prophecy of this book, for the time is near. Let the evildoer still do evil, and the filthy still be filthy, and the righteous still do righteousness, and the holy still be holy.

YESHUA- Behold, I am coming soon, and My reward is with Me, to pay back each one according to his deeds. I am the Alpha and the Omega, the First and the Last, the Beginning and the End. How fortunate are those who wash their robes, so that they may have the right to the Tree of Life and may enter through the gates into the city. Outside are the dogs and the sorcerers and the sexually immoral and the murderers and the idolaters, and everyone who loves and practices falsehood. I, Yeshua, have sent My angel to testify these things to you for My communities. I am the Root and the Offspring of David, the Bright and Morning Star. The Ruach and the bride say, "Come!" And let the one who hears say, "Come!" Let the one who is thirsty come—let the one who wishes freely take the water of life!
