LUKE 5

It happened that the crowds were pressing upon Yeshua to hear the word of God as He was standing by the Lake of Kinneret, when He saw two boats standing beside the lake. Now the fishermen had left them and were washing the nets. Getting into one of the boats, Simon's boat, Yeshua asked him to push out a ways from the land. Then sitting down, He taught the crowds from the boat. When He had finished speaking, He said to Simon,

YESHUA- Go out into the deep water, and let down your nets for a catch.

Simon replied,

PETER- Master, we've worked hard all night and caught nothing. But at Your word I will let down the nets.

When they had done this, they caught so many fish that their nets began to break. So they signaled to their partners in the other boat to come and help them. They came and filled both boats so full that they began to sink. But when Simon Peter saw this, he fell down at Yeshua's knees, saying,

PETER- Go away from me, Master, for I am a sinful man!

For amazement had gripped him and all who were with him, over the catch of fish they had netted; so also Jacob and John, Zebedee's sons, who were partners with Simon. But Yeshua said to Simon,

YESHUA - Do not be afraid. From now on, you will be catching men.

So when they had brought the boats to the landing, they left everything and followed Him.

Now while Yeshua was in one of the towns, a man covered with tza'arat appeared. And when he saw Yeshua, he fell on his face and begged Him, saying,

MAN WITH LEPROSY- Master, if You are willing, You can make me clean.

Yeshua stretched out His hand and touched him, saying,

YESHUA- I am willing. Be cleansed!

Immediately, the tza'arat left him.

Yeshua ordered him to tell no one, but commanded him,

YESHUA- Go and show yourself to the kohen. Then bring an offering for your cleansing, just as Moses commanded, as a testimony to them.

But the news about Yeshua was spreading all the more, and many crowds were coming together to hear and to be healed of their diseases. Yet He would often slip away into the wilderness and pray. Crowds Gather from the Galilee, Judea, and Jerusalem. Now on one of those days, Yeshua was teaching. Pharisees and Torah scholars were sitting there, who had come from every village of the Galilee and Judea, as well as from Jerusalem. And Adonai's power to heal was in Him. And behold, men were carrying a paralyzed man on a stretcher, trying to bring him in and place him before Yeshua. But when they found no way to bring him in because of the crowd, they went up on the roof and let him down with his stretcher through the tiles, right in the middle before Yeshua. When He saw their faith, He said,

YESHUA- Man, your sins are forgiven.

Then the Torah scholars and the Pharisees began to question, saying,

PHARISEE 1- Who is this fellow speaking blasphemies?

PHARISEE 2- Who can pardon sins but God alone?"

Yeshua, knowing their thoughts, replied to them,

<u>YESHUA-</u> Why are you raising questions in your hearts? Which is easier, to say, 'Your sins are forgiven you,' or to say, 'Get up and walk'? But so you may know that the Son of Man has authority on earth to pardon sins...." He said to the paralyzed one, I tell you, get up and take your cot, and go home!

Immediately he got up before them, picked up what he had been lying on, and went home, glorifying God. Astonishment took hold of them, and they glorified God and all were filled with awe, saying,

ALL- We've seen incredible things today!

LUKE 18:35-43

Now as Yeshua was approaching Jericho, a certain blind man was sitting by the road, *begging*. But when he heard the crowd going by, he asked what was happening. They told him that

<u>ISRAELITE 1</u>- Yeshua ha-Natzrati was passing by.

And he cried out, saying,

BLIND MAN- Yeshua, Ben-David, have mercy on me!

And those leading the way were scolding him, so he would be quiet. But he kept shouting all the more,

BLIND MAN- Ben-David, have mercy on me!

So Yeshua stopped and ordered the blind man to be brought to Him. And when he came near, Yeshua asked him,

YESHUA- What do you want Me to do for you?

And he said,

BLIND MAN- Master, I want to see again!

Yeshua said to him,

YESHUA- Receive your sight. Your faith has made you well.

Immediately the man received his sight and began following Yeshua, glorifying God. And when all the people saw it, they also gave praise to God.

MARK 5

They came to the other side of the sea, into the country of the Gerasenes. As soon as Yeshua got out of the boat, a man from the graveyard with an unclean spirit met Him. He lived among the tombs, and no one could restrain him anymore, even with a chain. For he had often been bound with shackles and chains, but the chains had been ripped apart by him and the shackles broken. No one was strong enough to tame him. And through it all, night and day, at the graveyard and in the mountains, he kept screaming and gashing himself with stones. When he saw Yeshua from a distance, he ran and bowed down before Him. Crying out with a loud voice, he said,

LEGION- What's between You and me, Yeshua, Ben El Elyon? I'm warning you, in the name of God, do not torment me!

For Yeshua had said to him,

YESHUA- Come out of the man, you unclean spirit!

Then Yeshua began questioning him

YESHUA- What is your name?

And he answered,

LEGION- My name is Legion, for we are many.

He kept begging Him not to send them out of the country. Now a large herd of pigs was feeding on the hillside nearby. The unclean spirits urged Him, saying,

LEGION- Send us to the pigs, so we may enter them.

So Yeshua gave them permission. The unclean spirits came out and entered the pigs. And the herd, about two thousand in number, rushed down the cliff and were drowned in the sea. The herdsmen ran away and told the town and countryside, and they came to see what had happened. Now they came to Yeshua and saw the madman who had had the legion. He was sitting there, dressed in clothes and in his right mind. The people were scared. Those who had seen it described in detail what had happened to the man plagued by a demon, and they also told about the pigs. And they began to beg Yeshua to leave their country. As He was getting into the boat, the man who had been infested with demons kept begging to remain with Him. Yeshua did not let him, but He told him,

YESHUA- Go home to your friends and tell them how much Adonai has done for you, how He showed you mercy.

So he went away and began to proclaim in the Decapolis how much Yeshua had done for him. And all were amazed.

When Yeshua had crossed over in the boat again to the other side, a big crowd gathered around Him; and He was by the sea. Then one of the synagogue leaders, named Jairus, comes. Seeing Him, he falls at His feet. He begs Him a great deal, saying,

JAIRUS - My little daughter is near death! Come and lay hands on her so that she may be healed and live!

So Yeshua went off with him, and a big crowd was following Him and pressing upon Him. And there was a woman with a blood flow for twelve years, who had suffered much under many doctors. She had spent all that she had without benefit; instead, she grew worse. When she heard about Yeshua, she came through the crowd from behind and touched His garment. For she kept saying,

WOMAN- If I touch even His clothes, I shall be healed.

Right away the blood flow stopped, and she felt in her body that she was healed from her disease. At once Yeshua knowing in Himself that power had gone out from Him, turned around in the crowd and said,

YESHUA- Who touched My clothes?

His disciples responded,

PETER- You see the crowd pressing upon You and you say, 'Who touched Me?'

But He kept looking around to see who had done this. But the woman, scared and shaking, knowing what had happened to her, came and fell down before Him and told Him the whole truth. And he said to her,

YESHUA- Daughter, your faith has made you well. Go in shalom and be healed from your disease.

While Yeshua was still speaking, messengers come from the house of the synagogue leader, saying,

ISRAELITE 1- Your daughter is dead. Why do you still trouble the Teacher?

But ignoring what they said, Yeshua tells the synagogue leader,

YESHUA - Do not be afraid; only believe.

He did not let anyone follow Him except Peter, Jacob, and John, the brother of Jacob. They come to the house of the synagogue leader. He sees a commotion, people weeping and wailing loudly. After entering, he said to them,

YESHUA- Why make such a fuss and weep? The child didn't die, but is sleeping.

They start jeering at Him. But after sending all of them out, He takes the child's father and mother, and those with Him, and enters where the child was. Then, taking hold of the child's hand, he tells her,

YESHUA- Talitha koum,"

which means, 'Little girl, I say to you, get up.' Immediately, the girl stood up and began to walk around! (She was twelve years old.) And they were overcome with astonishment. But He gave them strict orders that no one should know about this, and he said,

YESHUA- something to eat should be given to her.

MATTHEW 14:22

Right away, Yeshua made the disciples

YESHUA- get into the boat and go ahead,

of Him to the other side, while He sent the crowds away. After He had sent the crowds away, He went up on the hillside by Himself to pray. And when evening came, He was there alone. But the boat was already a long way from land, tossed around by the waves, for the wind was against it. Now in the fourth watch of the night, Yeshua came to them, walking on the sea. But when the disciples saw Him walking on the sea, they were terrified, saying,

PETER- It's a ghost!"

And they cried out with fear. But immediately, Yeshua spoke to them, saying,

YESHUA- Take courage! I am. Don't be afraid.

Answering, Peter said to Him,

PETER- Master, if it's You, command me to come to You on the water.

And he said,

YESHUA- Come!

And Peter got out of the boat and walked on the water to go to Yeshua. But seeing the wind, he became terrified. And beginning to sink, he cried out, saying,

PETER- Master, save me!

Immediately Yeshua reached out His hand and grabbed him. And He said to him,

YESHUA- O you of little faith, why did you doubt?

When they got into the boat, the wind ceased. And those in the boat worshiped Him, saying,

DISCIPLES- You really are Ben-Elohim!

After they had crossed over, they came to land at Gennesaret. And when the men of that place recognized Yeshua, they sent word into all the surrounding region. And they brought to Him all those who were in bad shape and kept begging Him that they might just touch the tzitzit of His garment—and all who touched it were cured.
